

Stuff To Take To The Beach

In each apartment you will find...

Beach Towels - They are big and blue and white. Please shake out the sand when you return from the beach.

Beach Chairs - They are in orange bags and very comfortable. Please rinse off the beach chairs when you return from the beach and let them dry. There are two upstairs and four downstairs.

Beach Coolers - They are red and white. Please rinse the coolers when you return from the beach and let them dry.

There is a small water cooler upstairs; there is a large ice chest downstairs.

Don't forget to take bug spray, sunscreen, something to eat, and lots of fluids to drink.

Take as few valuables to the beach as possible. If you drive to the beach, leave your car empty, unlocked and your windows rolled down. If you do take something valuable, take it with you to the water's edge and keep an eye on it.

Sun Bay has restrooms; Playa Caracas (the former Red Beach) has a pit toilet. Other than these two beaches, you are pretty much on your own.

Playa Caracas (and perhaps some of the other beaches) have sand spurs. These are nasty little weeds that will wreck your towels and wreck your feet. Try to avoid them at all costs.

Watch out for horses on the road if you drive. If you take a publico or taxi, please make sure you arrange in advance for a pickup time as cell phone service can be spotty on the Caribbean side of the island.

Some of the beaches have trash cans. Please remember to deposit your trash in a trash can or bring it back to town!
